Supplier curtailment methodology

This supplier curtailment methodology is published for the purposes of Rule 101B(2)(f) of the National Gas Rules.

Circumstances in which the service provider may curtail the injection of covered gas at a receipt point

For the VicHub, the service provider may curtail the injection of covered gas at a receipt point where that covered gas does not conform with the gas specification.¹

Process for the curtailment of injections of covered gas at receipt points

The injection of any covered gas injected at a receipt point which does not conform with the gas specification may be curtailed.

¹ The gas specification is set out in the relevant gas transportation agreement, connection agreement or other agreement with the service provider. An indicative gas specification for the VicHub is published on the pipeline's website.
